



MANUKA OVAL TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS FOR MAJOR EVENTS

Manuka Oval will host four AFL games in 2016, providing an opportunity for Canberrans to experience the excitement of live sport on a regular basis. To ensure there is minimal traffic congestion caused by the influx of spectators for these major sporting events, alternative traffic arrangements will be established for the areas surrounding Manuka Oval.

Modified traffic arrangements will commence two hours before the start of an event, will continue throughout the events and for up to three hours once an event concludes. On game days, modified traffic arrangements will be implemented on Manuka Circle and Fitzroy Street in Griffith, and residents living in this area may experience delays.

The ACT Government would like to thank you for your support of events at Manuka Oval, and your patience and understanding on game days.

TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS BEFORE AND DURING AN EVENT:

There will be no vehicle access to the west side of Manuka Circle via Canberra Avenue.

Manuka Circle will be closed to all traffic at the intersection of Manuka Circle and the Southern end of New South Wales Crescent to traffic heading south.

Local residents will be able to access and exit Fitzroy Street and Manuka Circuit (between Canberra Avenue and Fitzroy Street) via the road closure at the junction of Fitzroy Street and Empire Circuit.

Oxley Street will be closed west-bound to all traffic from Giles Street to Manuka Circle.

All traffic will be able to enter Oxley St east-bound from Manuka Circle.

Periodic short term closures of the inside east-bound lane of Canberra Avenue (no more than 45 minutes per closure).

POST-EVENT TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS:

All road closures will remain in place for up to one hour after the completion of any major event.

Temporary removal of time-related parking restrictions will remain in place for three hours after the completion of a major event.

Taxis will drop off and pick up at the Manuka Shopping Centre, and ride sharing services will drop off and pick up on the corner of Canberra Avenue and Furneaux Street, as well as the corner of Fitzroy Street and Empire Circuit.

ACTION buses will arrive and depart from the Eastern gate.
