- 24,154 persons dwelled here
 - 22,706 were 'at home' (not visiting)
 - 12,343 were female
 - 11,811 were male
 - 20,579 were 15 years and over, (14,040 were between 25 and 64 years old)
 - 361 were indigenous persons
 - 16,996 were born in Australia
 - 7,082 dwellers had parents who were born overseas, 1,925 had father only born overseas and 1,543 had mother only born overseas.
 - 19,114 spoke only English at home
- There were 20,579 persons aged 15 years and over, of whom
 - 13,345 were employed
 - 8,125 drive a car to work

Notes:

1. There is some apparent discrepancy in the mathematical calculations due to the rounding up of the square kilometre measure.
2. Land use (National Capital designated land, and ACT zoning) need to be taken into account when considering population densities. Designated land in the Inner South creates a marked comparative difference with other suburban areas. For example, Yarralumla has a large area of designated land which cannot be considered for infill. Other Inner South suburbs with designated land include Forrest, Barton and Parkes.
