# **DV369 Living Infrastructure**

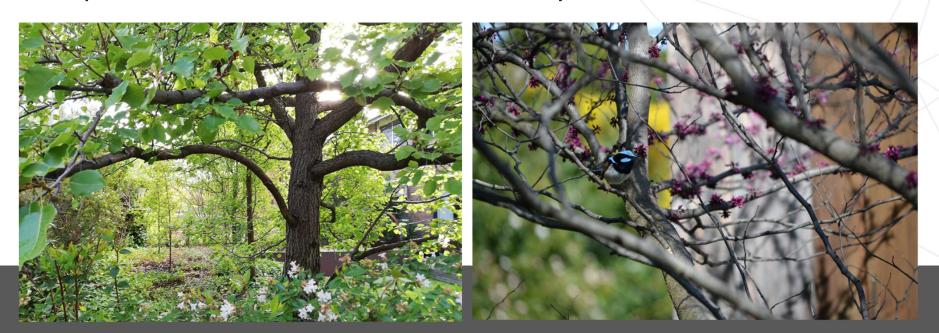
- Applies to all residential blocks (RZ1 – RZ5 zones)
- Changes the single dwelling and multi-unit dwelling codes to:
  - introduce site coverage requirement
  - strengthen definitions for
    - Site coverage
    - Planting area
  - increase the planting area required
  - introduce a requirement for tree planting
  - strengthen the existing criteria



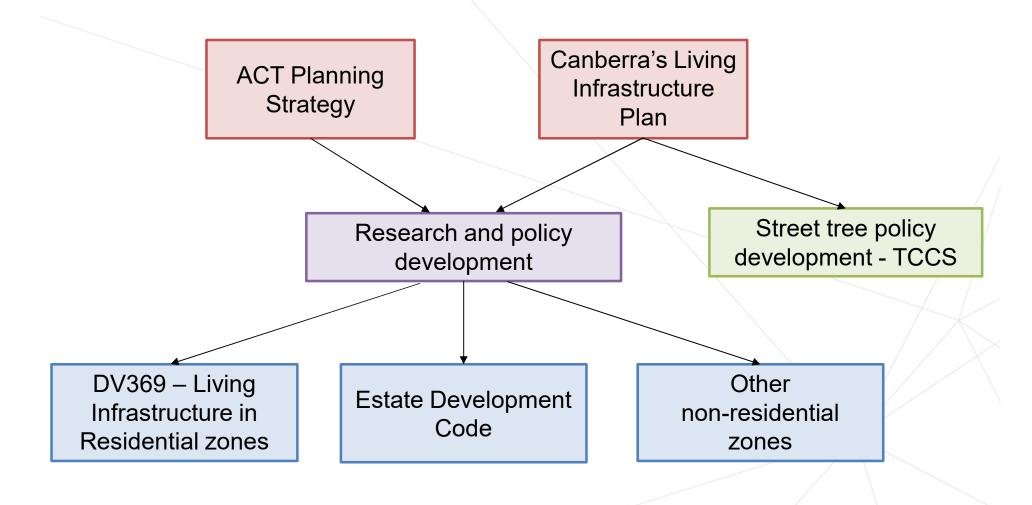


## DV369 Living Infrastructure

- Direction 3.3 of the **ACT Planning Strategy 2018** "Integrate living infrastructure and sustainable design to make Canberra a resilient city within the landscape".
- Action 2 of *Canberra's Living Infrastructure Plan* achieve 30% tree canopy cover (or equivalent) and 30% permeable surfaces in urban areas by 2045.



# Policy development





## Details of changes



- Amended definitions:
  - Site coverage amended to include roofed terraces, pergolas, patios, decks and balconies.
  - Planting area amended to exclude impermeable surfaces like terraces, pergolas, patios, decks, pools and the like.
- New definitions:
  - Canopy tree
  - Deep soil zone

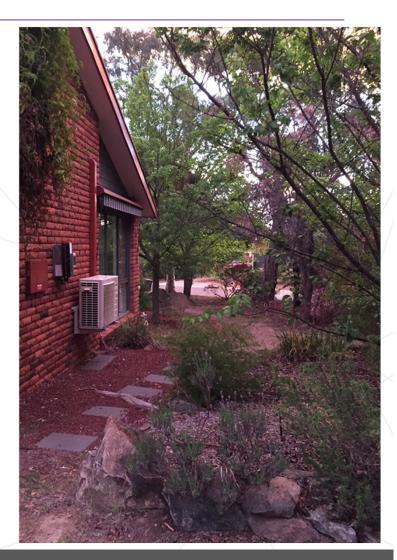
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## Other changes

- Amend relevant criteria to enable development to consider
  - deep root planting area
  - tree canopy
  - water infiltration
  - landscape quality
  - green roofs
  - green walls
- Minor corrections and amendments to update the development codes.





### To note



- Changes do not impact on the requirements of the *Tree Protection Act 2005* – tree protection and removal are still covered by this Act.
- Location of easements still needs to be considered.
- Existing trees on the block can be considered in meeting the requirements.

#### Amended definitions

- Site coverage: the proportion of the actual site covered by dwellings and all other buildings, including roofed terraces, pergolas, patios, decks and balconies but excluding any part of awnings, eaves and the like.
- Planting area means an area of land within a block that is
   available for landscape planting and is not covered by
   buildings, structures, vehicle parking and manoeuvring areas
   or any other form of impermeable element that impacts
   permeability of the ground surface (i.e. terraces, pergolas,
   patios, decks or pools surface and that is available for
   landscape planting.
