

ISCCC PRIORITIES AND ACTIONS FOR 2019

ISCCC Objectives (in Constitution)

- (a) To protect and enhance the amenity and environmental community well-being of Inner South Canberra residents and the broader community;
- (b) To promote and represent Inner South Canberra residents in respect of the above;
- (c) To actively promote communication and coordination among residents and local community groups;
- (d) To contribute to the planning of Inner South Canberra, consistent with the above objectives; and
- (e) To assist in ensuring all groups, especially the more vulnerable, are adequately represented.

PRIORITY 1: Advocate for integrated and effective urban planning in the inner south and across Canberra

GOALS	PROPOSED ACTIONS
1. Liveable, sustainable, resilient Inner South where heritage values are respected.	<p>1.1 Engage with inner south residents (including through an online survey) to identify what they value and would like to see protected or else what they would like to change in the inner south.</p> <p>1.2 Continue to engage actively in the Housing Choices process and in the Review of the Territory Plan to advocate for values/desired outcomes identified through community engagement:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Compile community and resident group feedback to date on the specific changes needed in the Territory Plan; (b) Agree on key “asks” to advocate for; (c) Take up the EPSDD offer to co-design community engagement for the Territory Plan review.

PRIORITY 2: Advocate for compliance with, and enforcement of, planning rules

GOALS	PROPOSED ACTIONS
2.1 Transparent, auditable Development Application (DA) processes.	2.1 Follow up status of, and respond to recommendations of, Legislative Assembly Inquiry into DA Processes
2.2 Effective and accountable inspection and compliance system	2.2 Collaborate with the Owners Corporation Network and other stakeholders in relation to building quality issues (both design and construction quality issues) and follow-up on the Legislative Assembly Inquiry into Building Quality.
2.3 Greater transparency and accountability in the deconcessionalisation of concessional leases	2.3 Advocate for no deconcessionalisation without an accompanying Development Application or detailed change to the Precinct Code. <i>(Evidence of influence of ISCCC advocacy: Detailed Consultation Report on LVC Review (Feb 2019) refers several times to ISCCC advocacy re-not reducing LVC).</i>

PRIORITY 3: Advocate for an integrated and effective transport, traffic management and parking system

GOALS	PROPOSED ACTIONS
3.1 Transport needs of inner south residents are met in a socially, economically and environmentally sustainable way: - including in areas with high proportions of public/community housing	3.1 Respond to the ACT Government's <i>Moving Canberra: Integrated Transport Strategy</i> 3.2 In the context of the upcoming 2019 Federal Election, identify a set of key issues on which to advocate, including in relation to safeguarding the role of the National Capital Authority in ensuring good quality outcomes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • eg re-light rail and associated land use in the central national area and on main avenues

PRIORITY 4: Advocate for effective community engagement in relation to local planning, development and heritage

GOALS	PROPOSED ACTIONS
4.1 Effective, timely and well-resourced community engagement	4.1 Prepare a hardcopy newsletter for distribution to inner south households, with a link to an online survey to determine what the community values, what they would like to preserve, or else what they would like to see change, in the inner south. 4.2 Maintain regular public forums, website, Facebook, Twitter and other communication channels

PRIORITY 5: Advocate for waste management strategies that minimise health and other risks to inner south residents

GOALS	PROPOSED ACTIONS
5.1 Any waste management facility and/or services minimise health and other risks to the Canberra community.	5.1 Monitor outcome of Environmental Impact Study (EIS) for CRS project. 5.2 Respond to relevant Development Applications, and undertake related advocacy.

PRIORITY 6: Strengthen ISCCC and member group capacity and capability

GOALS	PROPOSED ACTIONS
6.1 ISCCC and member groups have sufficient capacity, capability and resources to progress their objectives.	6.1 Agree on an approach to capacity building in the ISCCC, and for assisting ISCCC member groups to build capacity. 6.2 Build relationships with like-minded and/or relevant groups.
