# Purpose of engagement

# Background

March 2018



Three of the College's original buildings were demolished. Due to the friable asbestos, these buildings could not be upgraded.



January 2019



In term 3, 2018 22 new transportable buildings were installed on the oval. They provide contemporary learning and teaching spaces, as well as break out areas for students, and a range of specialist learning spaces.



June 2019



Landscaping on the area where the buildings were removed has now established and the transportable buildings, affectionately known as 'the Village' have become cemented as part of the teaching and learning spaces in the school.



Where to next?




Based on the feedback received during the consultation period, the ACT Government will develop a feasibility study and some initial concept development to begin to shape the future of the school.
